Countdown to the October 1, 2015 ICD-10 Compliance Date

The transition to ICD-10 is required for everyone covered by the Health Insurance Portability Accountability Act (HIPAA).

In accordance with CMS regulations, health care providers, payers, clearinghouses, and billing services need to comply with the transition to ICD-10 codes, which means effective with **October 1, 2015** dates of service. HealthCare Partners will only accept claims with ICD-10 diagnosis and inpatient procedure codes with dates of service (dates of discharge) on or after October 1, 2015. CMS has not provided a grace period so claims/encounters received with incorrect codes will be rejected resulting in delays that may impact your reimbursement so it's important to be prepared for the changeover to ICD-10 codes.

Other codes (CPTs, HCPCS, revenue codes, etc.) will not be impacted by this change.
